Associate membership does not grant this association the bargaining rights of the associate member, nor bind the associate member to any bargaining agreement consummated by this association and any Labor Union. Associate membership does not include membership in the Mechanical Contractors Association of Texas and in the Mechanical Contractors Association of America. Associate membership does not bestow any other legal rights, privileges or connotations in this association, except as provided in these Rules and Procedures for and by Associate Members.
